- ☐ Tuzla is the only city in Europe that has salt lakes and salt waterfalls, and the only city in which salt lakes, waterfalls and beaches are located in the very center of the city, and it attract about 400.000 visitors during the summer
- ☐ World Tourism Organization UNWTO (United Nations), awarded Tuzla City with Ulysss Award 2012 FOR INNOVATION IN PUBLIC POLICY AND MANAGEMENT, for the project "Valuation of Natural Heritage − Pannonian Salt Lakes Tuzla".
- Offering of a number of cultural institutions, i.e. the National Theatre Tuzla, Museum of Eastern Bosnia, the International Portrait Gallery "Ismet Mujezinovic" Tuzla, National University Library "Dervis Susic" Tuzla, Cinema ART Tuzla, Bosnian Cultural Center (BKC) Tuzla, House Tuzla and others.


Entreprenurial Infrastructure

Industrial and Business zones in Tuzla

- ☐ Industrial zone Bosanska Poljana and Plane (complex with over 800,000 m² of land), with located several companies, and there are available land plots for new investments.
- ☐ There is in construction a new Greenfield Business Zone Kreka-North, with 29 land plots approximate area of 4.000m² / per plot (with the possibility of inter-connecting the plots).
- ☐ The construction of new commercial and industrial zones in the city of Tuzla
- ☐ There is also significant potential of brownfield sites that may be appropriate for restructuring for new business operations
